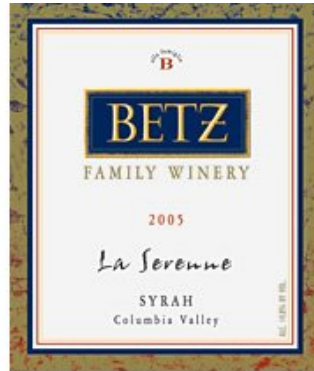

Bob Betz Philosophy: Start with the highest quality fruit you can. Treat it vigorously when necessary, gently most of the time, & stay out of its way, but watch it closely. Allow the wines to develop slowly, & make sure they provide pleasure.

Betz - Clos de Betz, Columbia Valley, WA, '03 \$65, '04 \$65

The Ciel du Cheval Cabernet Sauvignon grapes bring power to our Clos de Betz. '03 is tannic & powerful with rich layers of black fruit. '04 is a more serious wine than previous vintage – it's structure & length will reward with aging.

Betz - Clos de Betz, Columbia Valley, WA, '05 \$65

'05 - Grapes are from our blocks in the Horse Heaven Hills, Red Mountain & Yakima Valley in nearly equal proportions to make up the blend: 56% Merlot, 19% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 16% Malbec, 9% Cabernet Franc.

This is simply the best Clos de Betz we've made.

Betz – La Cote Rousse, Syrah, Red Mountain, WA '05 \$80, '06 \$80

The Scott Williams Vineyard is at one of the highest altitude sites on Red Mountain, & it forms the foundation of our La Cote Rousse. The grapes always ripen deeply here, providing the material to craft a Syrah with a high "yum" factor. '05 - 40% from Ciel du Cheval Vineyard & 60% from Scott Williams Vineyard - Red Mountain Blend. '06 – Four different clones from Ciel du Cheval & Scott Williams Vineyards. This mix of sites & clones endows it with a layered complexity & extra ordinary dimension.

La Cote Rousse presents a full spectrum of aromatic & palate impressions.

Betz – La Serenne, Syrah, Columbia Valley, WA '04 \$80, '05 \$80, '06 \$80

La Serenne has been one of the most consistently awarded & acclaimed wine we make, and it's 100% from Dick Boushey's Vineyard in Yakima Valley. This syrah is the only one of our wines that clearly reflects a single clone of one variety from a single vineyard. '04 - Will impress you with its overall palate impact: huge & yet supple. '05 has the same seamless palate impression as the '04, there is more of a fruit "lift" in both aroma & flavor that takes this wine to another dimension.

'06 - Mouth-feel texture enters plush & stays that way through to the finish.
